2 nd seal	Red horse: War	
3 rd seal	Black horse: Famine	
4 th seal	Pale horse: Death	
5 th seal	Martyrs	Cry for revenge – how long?
6 th seal	Day of the Lord	Sun black, moon red...

144,000 sealed -- Israel

Multitude (Gentiles) in white robes (focus passage)

7 th seal	Silence; earthquake	Incense thrown at earth

1 st trumpet	Judgment on land	Hail/fire/blood
2 nd trumpet	Judgment on the sea	Burning mountain
3 rd trumpet	Judgment on rivers	Falling star
4 th trumpet	Judgment on sky	Sun/moon/stars darkened
5 th trumpet	Army of locusts	First woe
6 th trumpet	Army of demons	Second woe

Measuring temple

Two olive trees/lampstands (Zech 4)

Two witnesses who are killed

7 th trumpet	“The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and his Messiah”	Earthquake Third woe

Understanding Judgment in Revelation

- God opposes evil and Empire out of God's love and true justice
- Read judgment as symbolic language describing the natural consequences of evil
- Understand that God's true power is the same power of weakness of the slain lamb

Take-aways

- God's victory already has been won through the death and resurrection of Jesus.
- God's reign is now (and not yet)
- Faithfulness to the way of Jesus will mean some form of suffering
- How we tell our story is crucial
