

Updated Summer COVID Safety Guidance for Worship, Education, and Meetings:

The COVID Task Force continues to review and update safety guidance for Alexanderwohl, with the goal of creating the safest policy for our congregation as a whole. Consideration has been given to current guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, mask-wearing fatigue, risks to the vulnerable, and advice from local medical experts about the continuing presence of the COVID virus in our communities and the implications of future risk for children and adults.

Guidance:

- People who are fully vaccinated do not need to wear face masks or socially distance, indoors or outdoors.
- It is recommended that unvaccinated people continue to wear face masks indoors. Masks do not need to worn outdoors.
- Participants should feel free to wear masks in any setting based on the concerns of personal level of risk for their loved ones and themselves, as well as church goers who may be in close proximity, even if vaccinated. Groups should give consideration to those who feel the most at risk in their group.
- During Worship, some pews will still be reserved for social distancing among those who need it.
- Attendance for Worship via Zoom will remain an option.
