Budget update: In the past weeks since the previous budget update, we have seen the generosity of Alexanderwohl come through. There have been

many varied positive responses to the request for additional support of our church's ministries and mission partners. As we enter the final weeks of the 2021, it appears that, based on current giving patterns, we will be within \$8,000 to \$10,000 of covering all of our expenses for our local church ministries for 2021.
