Context of “gifts” in Romans 12

12:1-2	Transformation	“Present your bodies...” “Do not be conformed...” “Be transformed in the renewal of your mind”
12:3	Humility	“Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment...”
12:4-6a	One body, many members	“so we, who are many, are one body in Christ...” “...we belong to each other.”
12:6b-8	List of gifts	Prophecy, service, teacher, encourager, giver, leader, compassionate
12:9-13	List of attributes of love	“Let love be genuine...”
12:14-end	The Christian life	“as far as it depends on you, live at peace...”
