Today -- May 21 -- Bethesda is hosting its 2nd Annual Fundraiser at the White Owl Barn (2861 Comanche Rd) from 5:00-7:00 pm. The evening

features a silent auction, lawn games and pulled pork meal. Suggested donations are \$15/plate for adults and \$8/plate for children 12 and under.

Goessel's Mennonite Heritage & Agricultural Museum is busy making plans for 2024 to celebrate the 150th Anniversary of the 1874 immigration of the Mennonites to the Goessel area. The committee is kicking off the celebration this Memorial Day by honoring and thanking our ancestors for their Faith, Courage and Action by placing a flag on each of the immigrant's graves. There will be over 400 flags in the Alexanderwohl cemetery alone and many in the Goessel and Tabor cemeteries. We will be reusing the flags next year for Memorial Day and again in September or October so look forward to visiting the cemeteries to see them all aflutter.

With Kim Funk's retirement at Tabor Mennonite Church, there is a need to gather a team of folks (at least one person from each of the three local congregations) to help administer the Food Pantry. This would involve being available at specified times during which folks could come to pick up food boxes, helping to stock the shelves as donations are brought, and doing minimal record keeping.
