Next Sunday, September 10, we'll begin using the Narrative Lectionary as the resource for sermons. This, in turn, can offer ways for us to connect with God and find ourselves within God's Story as we identify patterns and responses (both divine and human) across time and cultures. Pastor Lois will kick off the series next Sunday and then Pastor Rosie Jantz, formerly on the pastoral team at Tabor Mennonite Church, will continue on September 17. We'll have our Community Service Day on September 24. In October Pastor Tim Schrag will continue the series, preaching on October 1 (also World Communion Sunday), 8, 15 and 22. October 29 will be Mission Sunday; Tim Goertzen, Dwight M. Flaming and Delbert Peters will share about various missional projects and experiences.
