# **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

At the recommendation of the Board of Deacons, and as part of the transitional work of the congregation, Pastor Lois will take the remainder of her sabbatical time this summer that was not completed last summer. She will be on sabbatical for 8 weeks beginning June 17 through August 11. The Board of Deacons has secured pastoral coverage for this time with Robert Yutzy agreeing to serve with us at .5 FTE. Pastor Luann will continue with us in her Transitional Pastor role, also at .5 FTE.

Braxton Church and his family will be traveling to Children's Hospital of Colorado May 18-24 for multiple specialist appointments for Braxton's ongoing GI and airway disorders. They will also be meeting with a general pediatric surgeon to discuss surgery options as Braxton continues to struggle with severe abdominal pain & feeding issues.
