

The Board of Education at Alexanderwohl is offering a \$125.00 scholarship to each camper who calls Alexanderwohl their home congregation. This is for all children Grade 3 – Grade 12 (fall of 2025).

Register at <u>www.campmennosch.org</u> for Camp Mennoscah (look for the **Register on Line** button at the top of the page) and <u>www.RMMC.org</u> for Rocky Mountain Mennonite Camp. As soon as you have your child(ren) registered and have received your confirmation from camp, <u>let the church office know what dates your child(ren) will be attending camp.</u> You will then be reimbursed \$125.00 per child from the Board of Education.
